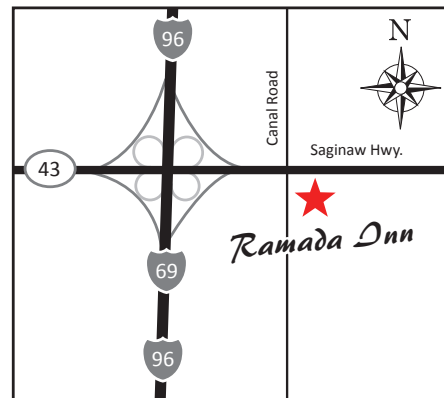
DRIVING DIRECTIONS
